
English:

The Lighthouse Keeper's Lunch

Our focus text this half term is *The Lighthouse Keeper's Lunch*. In our writing we will be making predictions about the text, generating adjectives to describe a setting and also using our knowledge of plurals to change words. We will also be focusing on the importance of sentence structure including; capital letters, finger spaces, full stops and using our conjunctions 'and' or 'but' within our sentences.

In our reading we will be developing our key skills when answering questions about our class text, as well as thinking of our own questions to ask.

We will have daily Monster Phonics lessons learning new sounds each day to help develop our reading and writing skills.

Lent

We will be exploring how Lent is a special time in the Church's year and how we can try to change, grow and be more like Jesus during this time.




Holy Week

We will be learning the names and sequencing the events of Holy Week and describing most of what happened on each occasion. We will also be discussing the people in the story and begin to understand the importance of the events for Christians today.

Maths: Addition/subtraction and shape.

During this half term, we will be looking at place value within 50, as well as exploring different forms of measurement including; length, height, mass and volume.



History: Explorers

We will be:

- Learning about Neil Armstrong
- Learning about Ernest Shackleton.
- Learning about Sir Ranulph Fiennes.
- Learning about and discussing Marco Polo



Music: Rock It Music


We will be taking part in music lessons with our Music teacher. We will learn how to play musical instruments and understand how to read music and the different features of music.



Science: Plants


We will be looking and labelling basic parts of a plant and tree and how seeds grow into plants. We will understand that different plants can grow in the same environment. We will be exploring evergreen and deciduous trees, know that fruits and vegetables are types of plants and finally plant and record the growth of our own plant.

Seeds grow into **larger plants** such as flowers, bushes and trees.




Computing: Data and information – Grouping Data

We will be beginning to learn how to label and group objects. We will then describe different objects and items and then create data sets by grouping and comparing data.



Design and Technology: Freestanding Structures

We will be exploring structures in our local area such as; our school playground and the play area. We will look at the materials that have been used for these structures and why. We will draw and label our own structures before finally making our own freestanding structure.
