

### **RE: Holy Communion Preparation**

The sacrament of **First Holy Communion** for year 3 pupils will be at St. Peter's Catholic Church on **Saturday 8th June 2024 at 1.30pm.**

### **Photography in church**

Photographs will be taken from 12:30pm by a professional photographer and will be completed before Mass starts. Please do not arrive before 12.30pm.

For safeguarding purposes **do not take photographs or recordings** of pupils or staff during any point of mass. We ask for mobile phones to be switched off whilst in church.

### **Dress code:**

Girls are to wear white dresses and boys are to wear grey trousers with a white shirt. Red ties and red sashes will be sent home, the week before, for the boys to wear. As they arrive at church all pupils will be given a First Holy Communion medal to pin on.

### **Seating arrangements**

During Mass, your child will sit with the other members of their class on the front benches of Church. One bench will be allocated to each family to attend the Mass (Max 6 adults). If you have more family attending, they are welcome to sit on other benches further back in the church.

### **Thanksgiving Party**

This academic year, we will be hosting a Communion Breakfast after the Sacramental mass in school. Parents are welcome to attend. We will host a party for Yr3 children in school too. This will be held on the afternoon of Friday 14<sup>th</sup> June 2024.

On the morning of Friday 14<sup>th</sup> June Y3 pupils are invited to wear their First Holy Communion clothes for Mass at 9.30am in school. They will also need to bring a change of clothes on this day.
