During the sessions Girls' bodies, Boys' bodies and menstruation – Girls and boys are taught separately. The focus of these lessons is to understand changes during puberty.

During the first lesson of Making babies children will learn:

- How a baby grows and develops in its mother's womb
- Pregnancy and childbirth are God's way of giving the gift of life: He creates new life, but entrusts parents with the job of making us

Children are not at any point during St Peter's taught about the process of making babies – the second Making babies session is optional and we therefore omit this.

Children also learn about protected characteristics:

- About prejudice, bullying and discrimination: what they mean and how to challenge them.
- About protected characteristics from the Equality Act 2010 such as race, age and disability.
- That everyone is made in the image of God, loved unconditionally by Him, has equal dignity and is deserving of equal respect.
