


English:

During our comprehension lessons we will be using our inference, retrieval, predicting and sequencing skills to answer questions on a variety of texts. There will be a clear focus on handwriting and presentation and we will continue to develop our knowledge on spelling patterns from the statutory year 3/4 word list.

Holy Week



Maths:

We will be learning:

- To partition, compare and order a mixed number
- To understand improper fractions and convert improper fractions to mixed numbers
- To add two or more fractions
- To add fractions and mixed numbers
- To subtract fractions
- To recognise tenths as fractions and decimals
- To divide a 1-digit and a 2-digit number by 10
- To recognise hundredths and fractions and decimals
- To divide a 1 or 2-digit number by 100



Geography: Rainforests

We will be learning:

 To recognise what a rainforest is and locate the



world's rainforests on a map

- To recognise the different layers of life in a rainforest
- To recognise the features that make up a rainforest
- To recognise the key characteristics of the Congo
- To describe and explain the impact of the deforestation of the rainforests
- To explain the importance of the Amazon Rainforest

Music: Rock It Music


Science: States of matter

We will be learning:

- To compare and group the 3 states of matter
- To explore how particles behave in solids, liquids and gases
- To investigate melting points
- To explore freezing and boiling points
- To explore evaporation and condensation
- To understand the water cycle

We will be taking part in music lessons with our Music teacher. We will learn how to play musical instruments and understand how to read music and the different features of music.





Computing: Data and information-Data logging

We will be learning:

- To explain that data gathered over time can be used to answer questions
- To use a digital device to collect data automatically
- To explain that a data logger collects 'data points' from sensors over time
- To recognise how a computer can help us analyse data
- To identify the data needed to answer questions
- To use data from sensors to answer questions
